Mary K. Grant, the 11th president of Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts (MCLA) and the first alumna of the College to serve as its president, has expanded MCLA's academic programming and facilities; overseen growth in enrollment; and has strengthened the connections between the College and the community through initiatives such as the Berkshire Compact for Education and the Berkshire Cultural Resource Center. In the fall 2013, MCLA will open the doors to a new 65,000 square foot Center for Science and Innovation.

Dr. Grant has served as the President of the Board for the Council of Public Liberal Arts Colleges (COPLAC); she is a member of the AACU President's Trust and serves on the Boards of MassINC, the Norman Rockwell Museum, and the John Adams Innovation Institute, among others. A champion for the advancement of the science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM), Dr. Grant is a member of Governor Patrick's STEM Advisory Board.
