Dr. Navedo has taught in the health professions for over 25 years, with broad expertise in clinical instruction and assessment in undergraduate, graduate, and post-licensure educational contexts. Building on her clinical practice as an emergency room nurse and as a Certified Pediatric Nurse Practitioner, Dr. Navedo's PhD in education became the entry point for scholarly examination of professional judgment development. Her work as faculty in Schools of Nursing at Yale, University of Massachusetts, and now MGH Institute of Health Professions has focused on faculty development initiatives as well as academic program development projects. Her current position includes teaching and research collaborations with the Harvard Center for Medical Simulation where she developed the first Certificate for Teaching and Learning with concentration in Healthcare Simulation, which draws participants internationally.
