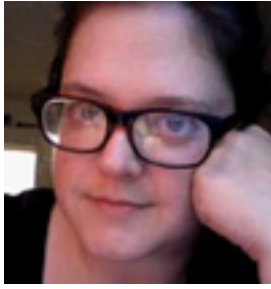


Carrie L. Saarinen
