Linda Wells is Dean of the College of General Studies and Professor of Humanities at Boston University. Prior to becoming Dean in 2000, she was Special Assistant to the Provost, where she directed the accreditation review for the University. Dr. Wells holds a Ph.D. in 20th Century British and American Literature from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and she has been on the faculty of Boston University's College of General Studies since 1980, where she taught humanities and was department chair of the Division of Humanities and Rhetoric. She continues her research in two areas: African-American literature and culture and Identity and Work. She holds a B.A. and an M.A. in English, both from Colorado State University. Her service to the University includes, among others, her roles as chair of Boston University's NCAA recertification process and chair of the SED dean's search.
