

Trudy W. Banta

A pioneer in outcome assessment in higher education and recipient of ten national awards for her work, Trudy Banta has consulted on the topic with faculty and administrators in 47 states in the United States, Costa Rica, Puerto Rico, South Africa, and the United Arab Emirates. She has given numerous invited addresses internationally and developed and coordinated 26 national and 15 international assessment conferences. Banta has written or edited 18 published volumes on assessment, including *Assessment Essentials: Planning, Implementing, and Improving Assessment on Higher Education*, co-authored with Catherine A Palomba (2014). She has contributed 30 chapters to other published works, and written more than 300 articles and reports. She is the founding editor of *Assessment Update*, a bi-monthly periodical published since 1989 by Jossey-Bass and winner of a national award for overall excellence in 2003 and the APEX Award for Editorial Writing in 2012. Dr. Banta is affiliated with the American Educational Research Association (AERA), the Association for the Study of Higher Education (ASHE), and the European Association for Institutional Research (EAIR). She holds a bachelor's degree in education and a master's degree in counseling from the University of Kentucky and a doctorate in educational psychology from the University of Tennessee.
