Suzi D'Annolfo has dedicated forty-six years to working with students and teachers as a public school educator (38 years in Connecticut) and, at the higher education level, in teacher-preparation and educational leadership at Central Connecticut State University and the University of Hartford. Dr. D'Annolfo has been a teacher, coach, athletic director, assistant principal, principal and Central Office Administrator in Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment (Newington Public Schools). While principal of Litchfield High School, CT, the school was recognized as a National Blue Ribbon School and Suzi received the prestigious Milken National Educator Award. As principal of Metropolitan Learning Center (MLC) Interdistrict Magnet School for Global and International Studies, CT, the school received numerous awards from the Magnet Schools of America as well as the Goldman-Sachs national award for the Outstanding Global and International Studies School. Currently, Suzi teaches at the University of Hartford in the teacher-preparation program, where she serves as Coordinator of School Partnerships. She works closely with the two magnet schools on campus, the University of Hartford Magnet School (UHMS – pre-K-5) and the University High School for Science and Engineering (UHSSE), which is a Hartford interdistrict magnet school, as well as numerous other schools. She has served NEASC on the Standards Revision Committee and as Chair of numerous accreditation visits for secondary schools.
