Dr. Betof began his teaching career at Northfield Mount Hermon School. He is a lecturer in University of Pennsylvania's Mid-Career Doctoral Program in Educational Leadership and a faculty member in the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS) School Leadership Institute. He has served on the Board of Directors of the Friends Council on Education since 2009 and joined the Board of Trustees of Cambridge Friends School in 2015.
