**Mary Loeffelholz** is Interim Dean of the College of Professional Studies and Professor of English at Northeastern University. Loeffelholz, a distinguished scholar of American literature, has been a member of Northeastern's faculty since 1988 and has held a variety of key academic leadership roles. She chaired the English department from 2001 to 2006, served as associate dean for faculty affairs and director of the former College of Arts and Sciences' graduate school from 2006 to 2007, was special assistant to the President for academic affairs in 2007-08, and served as Vice Provost for Academic Affairs from 2008 to 2016. She was a member of the Faculty Senate Agenda Committee from 1992 to 1994 and has served in various leadership roles on the Faculty Senate and its committees. She earned her doctorate in English and American literature from Yale University, and her bachelor's and master's degrees from Stanford University.
