Dr. Christopher Hourigan is currently the Director of Institutional Research & Planning at Rhode Island College (RIC) in Providence, RI. In this role, he leads efforts to improve data integrity and governance at RIC; oversees official reporting for the college; supports program and institution-wide assessment; conducts research on critical institutional issues, such as retention and recruitment; and plays a key role in strategic planning. Prior to his appointment at RIC, Dr. Hourigan held similar positions at public and private institutions in New England and New Jersey. He has presented at national and regional institutional research conferences on topics such as data governance, the role of institutional research in policy making, and use of survey results for assessment. He has also served on a NEASC visiting team as the reviewer for the Educational Effectiveness standard. Dr. Hourigan holds a bachelor's degree from Bowdoin College, a master's degree from the Harvard Graduate School of Education, and a doctorate from Teachers College, Columbia University.
