## **Participation in Community Meeting**

- 1 - Shows up to the meeting if reminded but remains disengaged.
- 2 - Observes interactions and begins to understand the meeting's dynamics.
- 3 - Asks questions and seeks clarification on issues discussed.
- 4 - Offers constructive reflections and suggestions during discussions.
- 5 - Takes on a leadership role by chairing or facilitating the meeting.

## **Community Responsibility**

- 1 - Does not participate in community activities or take on responsibilities.
- 2 - Engages in simple chores and responsibilities within the community.
- 3 - Takes initiative in fulfilling community roles and responsibilities.
- 4 - Advocates for fairness and equality within the community setting, through responsibility.
- 5 - Inspires others to take responsibility and fosters a sense of collective ownership and community spirit.

## **Advocating for Oneself**

- 1 - Does not actively pursue personal interests or speak up for oneself.
- 2 - Seeks information about opportunities related to interest.
- 3 - Actively pursues interests and passions through participation in related activities.
- 4 - Confidently advocates for personal needs and interests in various settings.
- 5 - Inspires others to pursue their own interests through role modeling and mentorship.

## **Autonomous Learning**

- 1 - Relies heavily on adults for guidance and direction.
- 2 - Sets some personal learning goals and seeks out resources with guidance.
- 3 - Actively participates in setting learning goals and planning actions to achieve them.

4 - Independently sets and assesses personal learning goals.

5 - Fully takes charge of their learning process, including setting, pursuing, and evaluating complex goals.
