

Coleen Pantalone



Professor Pantalone joined Northeastern University in 1981 as an assistant professor of finance after earning a bachelor's degree in economics from the University of Minnesota and a doctorate in economics from Iowa State University. In 1987 she was promoted to associate professor, and continues to conduct research on investments and financial markets. Professor Pantalone served as associate dean for undergraduate programs in the College of Business Administration from 1993 to 1996. She became vice provost for undergraduate education and executive vice provost in 1999, overseeing faculty development, budget planning, long-term planning, and University libraries. In 2000-2003, she led the University's conversion to semesters. In January 2004, Professor Pantalone returned to the faculty. She again served as associate dean for undergraduate programs. Professor Pantalone joined the College of Professional Studies on an interim basis in 2015 to manage the part-time undergraduate programs. She will return to faculty in 2017.
